## SECRETARY'S REPORT.

Since the Annual General Meeting on the 9th May, 1964, there have been Committee Meetings on the 6th June, 1964, 3rd October, 1964, 12th December, 1964, and 13th March, 1965. Representatives of the Committee attended the inaugural meeting of the Council of Southern Caving Clubs in Bristol on the 9th January, 1965. The meeting about the proposed National Association has been delayed on two occasions at the request of the Southern Council; the meeting is now scheduled for the 29th May, 1965.

The Agreement with Messrs. Davis and Bowring, Gisburn, for access to the land owned by the Dawson family (parts of Penyghent and Fountains Fell) took effect from the 3rd October, 1964, and has been operating successfully since. The Leck/Casterton agreement has been working smoothly, and one or two minor snags ironed out without difficulty - the old sled road is now marked out and a stile has been erected in memory of our late Treasurer, Alan Clegg, above County Pot. A very limited trial agreement has now been negotiated with Mr. Coates for the remainder of Fountains Fell and this will be explained fully at the General Meeting. No further progress has been made about the payment for the use of the Alum Pot footpath, and we are still waiting for the West Riding Planning Committee to publish their definite footpaths map. Now difficulties have arisen in the Meregill area, Dentdale and at Mungo Gill.

Slow progress is being made with the 'Know The Game' booklet. The access booklet is under review and it is hoped that a list of survey availability will be a part of the next edition.

My sincere thanks are due to my colleague and Meets Secretary, Mick Melvin, who has made my job a lot lighter and himself performed a very difficult, thankless task. Even so, several hundreds of letters have been written, and the number continues to grow. The services of the C.C.P.R. in producing and mailing our minutes are greatly appreciated, and have helped me to concentrate on pressing access problems.

Membership of the Council now totals 48 member clubs, of which 23 are full members and 25 associate members.
